

**CITY OF VACAVILLE
COMPRESSED NATURAL GAS (CNG) VEHICLE INCENTIVE PROGRAM

In addition to the \$25,090 figure listed for the 2009 Honda Civic GX, there is a \$670 destination and handling charge that brings the MSRP to \$25,760.

Here is a summary of how the incentives will work.

Federal Tax Credit - \$4,000 (One-time, good through 2010, and dependent on your tax status and whether you are subject to the Alternative Minimum Tax which could limit the amount that you can actually receive)

City of Vacaville Incentive - \$4000 incentive to those who qualify for our incentive program. Those who live or work full-time (verifiable) in the northeastern portion of Solano County, essentially the cities of Vacaville, Dixon, Rio Vista, and the town of Elmira, and the unincorporated area of this part of the County, are eligible for our incentive.

Dealership Incentive - \$1000 incentive to those who qualify for our incentive program. Those who live or work full-time (verifiable) in the northeastern portion of Solano County, essentially the cities of Vacaville, Dixon, Rio Vista, and the town of Elmira, and the unincorporated area of this part of the County, are eligible for our incentive. The dealership is providing the \$1000 incentive only for those who qualify for our program.

So that means that the MSRP would be reduced by the dealer cash incentive of \$1000 up front at the time of delivery. The City of Vacaville incentive of \$4000 will then be applied further down on the purchase agreement. Then when you do your federal tax return for the year of delivery there is the possibility of receiving the benefit of a \$4,000 federal tax credit, depending on your tax status.

The Honda Civic GX does still qualify for the white High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) decals, enabling you to drive solo in the carpool lanes in the Bay Area and the Sacramento Area during commute hours. With the decals on the vehicle, you are also exempt from the bridge tolls throughout the Bay Area during the posted commute hours (same as carpools).

As gasoline prices are on the rise again right around \$3.00 per gallon, the price of compressed natural gas at the PG&E public refueling facilities for the month of July is only \$1.79 per gasoline gallon equivalent (gge), down \$0.40 since January. The application must be completed prior to taking delivery of the Honda Civic GX in order to be eligible for the City of Vacaville incentive.
