EARTH EXPO COMES TO DOWNTOWN VACAVILLE ON SATURDAY, SEPT. 6

The public is invited to visit Historic Downtown Vacaville for an exciting day to learn about our environment and how to reduce its carbon foot print.

The Earth Expo will be held in Downtown Vacaville from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. on September 6. The event is free to the public and is located along the 200 block of Main Street (by Gold's Gym) where you will find green, eco-friendly vendors and information. The 300 block of Main Street will feature the weekly Farmers' Market but with extended hours from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.

The central focus of the Earth Expo is alternative fuel vehicles. Exhibitors include City Coach with a Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) bus; a Honda Civic GX (powered by CNG) and the Phill Home Refueling Appliance for CNG cars. Davis Electric Cars will show off some neighborhood electric vehicles. Miles Motors plans to have a low-speed electric truck, a low-speed electric sedan, and a Vectrix electric scooter. They will also have pictures, information, and will be accepting pre-orders on the XS500 highway speed electric vehicle which will be out early in 2009. Ray's Cycle will have bicycles on display.

Other confirmed vendors are Barnes & Noble with a selection of green, eco-friendly books for adults and children, Reach & Teach with earth friendly science kits including a hybrid toy car, REC Solar, United Glass, Tupperware, and Yolo-Solano Air Quality Management District.

In the Chamber Courtyard musical entertainment will be provided by Loren Davidson, Tony Bataska, and The Robber Barons. The Courtyard will also be the site of Organic Beer and Wines, sold by the glass, or by special tasting tickets.
