Reno- 4th of July Baseball- July 4-5: Celebrate America's greatest pastime in the new Reno Stadium with the Sacramento Rivercats and the Reno Aces. Package includes overnight accommodations at the Grand Sierra Resort Hotel, bus transportation, and stopover at the Silver Legacy for six hours on the first day and four hours at Boomtown on the way home. \$149 per person, dbl,
