ASPHALT OVERLAY PROJECT TO BEGIN PAVING FIRST WEEK OF JUNE

The City of Vacaville will begin paving operations on several streets as early as June 2 and will continue over the following two weeks, weather permitting.

The work to be done consists of resurfacing Alamo Drive from Interstate 80 to Nut Tree Road, Peabody Road from California Drive to Beelard Drive, Gilley Way from Leisure Town Road to Orange Drive, Allison Drive from Elmira Road to Ulatis Drive, and Helen Power Road from Burton Road to Nut Tree Parkway.

The majority of the work will occur between the hours of 7 a.m. and 6 p.m., so motorists should expect significant delays if traveling in these areas. Motorists are encouraged to use alternate routes during this period.

American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA), Proposition 42, Green Tree Assessment District, and Allison/Ulatis Assessment District funds are providing the majority of funding for this overlay project. Local gas tax revenues are also providing partial funding.

In accordance with the City's minimum performance standards for street maintenance, arterials typically receive an overlay every 10 years for cost-efficient preventive maintenance. The cost for a complete road reconstruction is much higher than the cost to overlay a road when comparing dollars per life of road. Overlaying the road will prevent water intrusion into the road structural section, ensuring longer roadway life and better drivability.
