**Solano County Public Health to Conduct Free H1N1 Flu Clinic
During the Solano County Total Home & Garden Show in Vacaville**

WHAT: Solano County Public Health will be conducting H1N1 vaccinations at the Solano County Total Home and Garden Show. This is a free walk-in clinic to administer H1N1 vaccinations to visitors during the hours of the show.

WHEN: Friday, April 16, noon to 6 p.m.
Saturday, April 17, 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.
Sunday, April 18, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

WHERE: Nut Tree complex, next to Lowe's, 1751 East Monte Vista Ave, off Nut Tree Road, Vacaville.

WHO: This free clinic will be open to anyone seeking an H1N1 vaccination. Children age nine and under are encouraged to get their second H1N1 vaccination (booster dose) as long as their first vaccination was at least three weeks ago.
