PERMIT RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Public Works Department is to be notified 24 hours in advance of any construction.
2. For work within the public right-of-way, barricades must be kept on all trenches, excavations and obstructions. Lights must be maintained at night. All warning and safety devices to conform to current "manual of warning signs, lights and other devices for use in performance of work upon highways", issued by the State of California, Department of Public Works.
3. Access to fire hydrants shall be maintained at all times. Access to adjacent property shall be provided.
4. When work is within the public right-of-way, the use of flagmen is mandatory where the (1) two-way vehicular traffic has less than twenty-four (24) feet in which to pass; or, (2) where the vehicular traffic must pass to the left of dividing islands in passing the site of the construction. Closing of streets requires the approval of the City Traffic Engineer, the Police and Fire Departments.
5. Applicants must obtain all other permits required by other public or private agencies or individuals necessary in order to perform the intended work. If this provision is not complied with, this permit shall be null and void. It shall be the responsibility of the applicant to notify the utility companies and cable TV before starting any construction that may involve their underground or overhead facilities.
6. Applicant shall indemnify and save harmless the City of Vacaville, its officers and agents, from all suits or actions of every name and description, brought for, or on account of any injuries or damages received or sustained by any person or persons, by or from the applicant, his servants or agents, in the construction of the work or by or in consequence of any negligence in guarding the same, or for improper materials used in its construction.
7. The permittee agrees to relinquish the cash bond submitted if any portion of this permit is not complied with and if the City is required to perform any work.
8. The permittee agrees to relinquish any portion of the cash clean-up deposit that may be required by the City to provide street maintenance or safety measures related to this project, if permittee does not comply with written City requests.
9. Refunds are mailed approximately the 5th and 20th of each month.
