On September 4, 2007 the Solano County Coroner's office conducted an autopsy on the white male that was found deceased in the vacant field behind the Mervyn's Department Store.

The preliminary results of that autopsy did not indicate any signs of foul play or criminal activity that contributed to the death of this individual. The exact cause of death is pending the results of toxicology tests.

The Coroner's has identified the deceased male. That information will be released by the Coroner's office following the notification of his family.

Original Press Release

On September 1, 2007 at approximately 12:00 noon the Vacaville Police Department Communication Center received a report of a possible dead body in the vacant lot located to the rear of the Mervyns Department Store. Patrol Officers were dispatched and they located a deceased white male adult in that vacant lot.

The deceased male appeared to be approximately 40 to 60 years old. He had gray hair and a gray beard. As of this writing no positive identification has been established. The Solano County Coroner responded and collected the deceased. An autopsy will be conducted in the next few days in hope of determining a cause of death. The coroner will also attempt to determine the identity of the deceased.

An investigation of the immediate area revealed approximately 5 – 6 small homeless camps. It is unknown at this time if the deceased male was homeless or if he lived in one of the nearby homeless camps.
