Narrative:

On January 11, 2008 at approximately 9:12 pm the Vacaville Police Department Communications Center received a report of a robbery which just occurred at Subway, 2038 Nut Tree Road.

Employees inside the business stated a male suspect wearing a mask entered the business with a silver handgun. The suspect ordered one of the employees to the cash register and demanded money at gun point. The suspect was given an undisclosed amount of cash, threatened the employees and left the business on foot.

Officers arrived on scene and flooded the area. Officer Moriarty spotted a subject matching the description a block away from the business. The suspect ran from Officer Moriarty who gave chase on foot. During the foot pursuit the male suspect discarded the money along the way.

A perimeter was set up by responding officers and the CHP helicopter was called to the scene. A yard to yard search using K-9's was conducted. During the yard search officers found that the suspect had discarded his pants, shirt and shoes. S-Tyler was found on the side yard of a residence wearing only sweat pants and socks. He was arrested and later took officers to where he had discarded the handgun. The handgun, money and clothing were recovered. S-Tyler was arrested for the above listed charges.
