Narrative:

At approximately 1544 hours the Vacaville Police Department received a report of an attempted rape that had just occurred. The report indicated victim was walking west on a dirt path from the 300 block of Brown Street. The victim was walking towards Rocky Hill Road when she was confronted by an unknown male suspect. The suspect grabbed the victim and allegedly forced her into some nearby bushes. The suspect then brandished a knife, tore the victim's clothes and attempted to sexually assault the victim.

The victim attempted to fight off her attacker and tried to run away. The suspect physically assaulted the victim as she tried to run away. The suspect was apparently distracted by a nearby barking dog and fled the area on foot. The victim ran to a nearby facility for help and to report the crime. Officers and detectives responded into the area, established a perimeter and searched for the suspect. Officers were unable to locate the suspect.

The victim described the suspect as a white male, approximately 5'5" tall, 140 lbs. with a thin build. The alleged suspect had dark brown shoulder length hair that was combed over to the right. The alleged suspect was wearing a crown earring in his left ear.
