Narrative:

On June 16, 2008, Vacaville Police Department received information that a citizen wanted to report incidents of alleged child molestation. The investigation was assigned to detectives from the Family Investigative Response Services Team (FIRST). Three victims were subsequently interviewed at the Rainbow Children's Center in Vacaville which produced evidence that substantiated the above crimes.

As a result of the interviews, detectives attempted to locate S-Clark however, he had fled the area. Detective's continued their investigation and secured an arrest warrant for S-Clark. Additionally, FIRST detectives worked with the United States Marshall's Service Fugitive Task Force and other agencies in an attempt to locate S-Clark.

On June 18, 2008, S-Clark surrendered to detectives at Vacaville Police Department. S-Clark was taken into custody and booked into Solano County Jail with bail set at \$1,500,000. This case is still under active investigation, therefore no additional information will be available at this time.
