Narrative:

On 07/02/08, at approximately 1:13 p.m., a concerned citizen brought a juvenile victim to the F.I.R.S.T. (Family Investigative Response Services Team) office. The citizen wanted to report that the victim had been physically abused. F.I.R.S.T. Detectives met with the victim and determined the victim would require medical attention for her injuries. The victim was transported to the Vaca Valley Hospital emergency room for medical treatment.

The subsequent investigation revealed the victim had been beaten with a belt and rope. S-Arceneaux was identified as the suspect and was subsequently arrested. The suspect was booked into the Solano County Jail where her bail was set at \$53,332. The victim and her two siblings were taken into protective custody and released to the custody of Solano County Child Welfare Services.

The Vacaville Police Department would like to remind parents that there are other alternatives to physical discipline. The Vacaville Police Department strongly recommends that parents not impose physical discipline while angry. The Vacaville Police Department offers classes on parenting and nurturing children.
