Narrative:

On 3/22/08 at approximately 1724 hours, officers responded to the Jack in the Box, 1035 Alamo Dive, (in the Golden Hills Plaza) in reference to an in progress robbery. Two masked gunmen wearing dark clothing entered the business and demanded money from the clerk at gun point. They both exited the business with an undisclosed amount of cash and ran southwest toward Marshall Road. A perimeter was set up by officers. The CHP fixed wing aircraft and a K-9 was used to look for the outstanding suspects. Sgt. Jim Mayoral spotted one of the suspects on Devonshire Drive and chased the suspect on foot, catching him and arresting him without incident. This suspect had the stolen cash on his person. The second suspect was located inside the perimeter and was arrested without incident. The ski masks and both replica handguns were recovered along the flight path of the suspects. One male suspect was 14 years old and the other was 15 year old. Their names are being withheld due to their juvenile status. Prior to the robbery both suspects attempted to steal money from a female at the 99 Cent Store in the Golden Hills Plaza, but were unsuccessful. ISS detectives were called to the scene. They interviewed both suspects who admitted to the robbery and attempt robbery at the Jack in the Box. Both were charged with Robbery, attempt robbery and conspiracy. Additional investigation revealed they were also the responsables in the robberies which occurred at the 7-11 store, 1450 Alamo Drive on 3/18/08 and the robbery at Valleys Food Market, 1100 Marshall Road on 3/11/08. They were additionally charged with Robbery and Conspiracy on both of those cases. Both were booked into juvenile hall.
