Narrative:

On the above date and time detectives from the Vacaville Police Department's Narcotics (NET) and Crime Suppression Teams (CST) served a search warrant at the 200 block of Bowline Drive in Vacaville. The search warrant was the culmination of a six month investigation of Michael Allen by Vacaville Narcotics Detectives for sales of cocaine and other controlled substances. (S) Allen attempted to destroy narcotics when police initially announced their presence at the front door to his residence. Detectives were able to recover approximately one ounce of methamphetamine and cocaine, as well as some rock cocaine, before it was destroyed. Vacaville Police K-9 Kora searched the premises and assisted in locating narcotics and evidence related to the sales of methamphetamine and cocaine. A search of the residence, which is shared by Allen and Miller, located methamphetamine and cocaine packaged for sale, a small amount of marijuana, and evidence of narcotics trafficking. Detectives seized \$980 in suspected drug proceeds from the suspects.

Allen and Miller were arrested for possession of cocaine, cocaine base, and methamphetamine for sale. Both Allen and Miller were also arrested for child endangerment as four children, ages 12-16 reside with them in the residence where the narcotics were present. Allen was also arrested for destruction of evidence. Allen and Miller were transported to the county jail in Fairfield for booking. Detectives from the Family Investigative Response Services Team were called to the home and the children were placed into protective custody.

The Vacaville Police Department has a zero tolerance policy towards illegal drug use in our community. We enjoy a healthy partnership with our citizenry and rely heavily on public information to combat the flow of drugs into our neighborhoods.
