### **Narrative:**

On March 12, 2009, at approximately 11:07 a.m., Vacaville Patrol Officers, Youth Service Officers and Detectives from the Vacaville Police Department Family Investigative Response Services Team responded to a south Vacaville residence regarding a disturbance. Officer's encountered S-Grant, who refused to comply with any directions or orders of Officers. S-Grant began punching a wall before he jumped out of a second story window and tried to flee the scene. S-Grant was detained by Officers as he attempted to flee the scene.

Officers and Detectives at the scene contacted a victim at the residence. Investigation showed the victim had scratches and other injuries on her neck from being strangled. The victim had numerous bruises and other injuries on her torso, arms and legs from being beaten with wooden poles. Officers seized the wooden poles at the scene.

Detectives from the Family Investigative Response Services Team assumed the investigation. Detectives learned the suspect used threats and repeatedly beat the victim in an effort to physically and emotionally control the victim. The suspect forced the victim to perform acts of prostitution for his financial gain. Detectives are investigating the suspects link to human trafficking in the Bay Area.



The suspect was subsequently taken into custody and booked into the Solano County Jail. The suspects bail was enhanced to \$150,000. This case is under active investigation. Anyone who believes they may have information regarding this case is asked to call Detective Miller at 707-469-6600.
