Narrative:

March 23, 2009, at approximately 10:00 a.m., the Vacaville Police Department, Family Investigative Response Services Team (F.I.R.S.T.) received a report regarding criminal threats. Officers initiated an investigation and learned the victim in this case reported (on 03-23-09) that S-Alfaro had entered her residence while the victim was gone. S-Alfaro left a black bag containing a homemade picture frame of the victim and a note written to her. S-Alfaro knew his victim. The victim reported S-Alfaro made approximately 50 threatening phone calls to her within 72 hours. Officers attempted to locate the suspect on 03-23-09, but were unsuccessful.

On March 24, 2009, at approximately 10:00 a.m., the victim came to the F.I.R.S.T. Office for assistance. The victim reported that S-Alfaro had just made another threatening telephone call to her. Detectives and officers located the suspect at 1401 East Monte Vista Avenue. Detectives arrested S-Alfaro without incident. Officers located items taken from the victims residence in the pockets of S-Alfaro. S-Alfaro was subsequently booked into the Solano County Jail. This case is under active investigation.
