The Vacaville Police Department conducted a multi-agency Sex Offender Compliance Sweep on April 1, 2009 between 2:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m.. The purpose of the Sex Offender Compliance Sweep was to ensure convicted sex offenders complied with their registration, probation and/or parole conditions. This operation involved detectives from the Vacaville Police Department Family Investigative Response Services Team (FIRST) and the Vacaville Police Department Crime Suppression Team (CST), Vacaville Police Tactical Dispatchers, Vacaville Police Records Clerks and Crime Analysts along with Deputies from the Solano County Sheriff's Office Community Oriented Policing and Prevention Team (COPPS), Probation Officers from Solano County Probation, Parole Agents from the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation, Fairfield 2 GPS Parole Unit and Deputy U.S. Marshals from the United States Marshals Service.

The operation involved five (5) teams that visited designated locations throughout Vacaville. The teams conducted thirty-five (35) compliance checks and made nine (9) arrests. The Vacaville Police Department and our allied agencies from the County, State and Federal government are committed to the safety of the community. This sex offender sweep would not have been possible without the invaluable cooperation and partnership with our allied agencies and the community.
