Narrative:

On April 4, 2009 at 8:40 a.m., Officers responded to the area of Berryessa Drive on a report of a strong arm robbery that just occurred in which a subject confronted two minors and demanded property. Upon arriving at the scene, a subject matching the description was seen running into a nearby back yard in the 300 block of Berryessa Drive. A perimeter was established to try and locate the suspect who was on foot, however, within minutes a silver Honda sped away from the area at a high rate of speed. Officers in the area observed the driver who matched the description. The driver accelerated quickly heading east on Marshall Road toward Nut Tree Parkway in an attempt to flee the area, but by the time Officers could locate the car, it had already crashed into a retaining wall at Marshall Road and Nut Tree Parkway, with the driver fleeing on foot into the neighborhood. Officers soon discovered that the car had just been stolen from the neighborhood where the suspect was first seen. With the assistance of a helicopter and a police K-9, Officers thoroughly searched areas that the suspect may have been hiding, but were unable to locate him.
