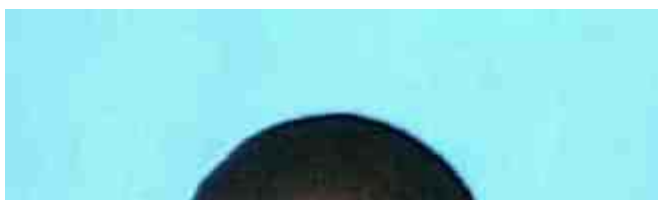
Narrative:

On April 24, 2009 at approximately 3:20 p.m., Officers from the Vacaville Police Department responded to the Nut Tree Factory Stores regarding a report of two subjects who had attempted to pass fraudulent travelers cheques. Officers were able to locate S-1 Harper and S-2 Jackson as they attempted to leave the area in their vehicle and return to San Leandro.

The Officers located property from more than ten (10) different stores located in the Nut Tree Factory Stores area inside the suspects vehicle, along with more than \$3,000.00 in fraudulent travelers cheques and a dozen fraudulent preloaded gift cards. The suspects used the fraudulent cards and cheques to purchase more than a \$1,000.00 worth of goods from the stores. The Officers were able to recover the property and return it to the merchants.

The suspects were charged with ten (10) counts of burglary and possession of stolen property, in conjunction with their possession of fraudulent travelers cheques and gift cards. They were both booked into Solano County Jail.

The Vacaville Police Department, in conjunction with our local merchants, will continue to work together to take a zero tolerance stance with those that attempt to burglarize or steal from our merchants. The Department will aggressively investigate these cases and pursue prosecution.
