Narrative:

On May 10, 2009 at 1:12 AM, Officer Keith Hopper observed two suspicious subjects walking near a hotel in the 100 block of Lawrence Drive. The two subjects quickly fled from Officer Hopper and into the lobby of the hotel where two other suspects were located. Officer Hopper gave chase and requested additional officers to respond. Once a sufficient number of officers were on scene, a search of the immediate area revealed a loaded handgun. Officers also discovered illegal narcotics on two of the suspects. Arrested were:

- Javier Garcia – possession of narcotics, carrying a loaded firearm not registered to him and possession of a loaded firearm while possessing illegal drugs.
- Jesus Garcia – Possession of narcotics, possession of controlled substance w/o prescription, transporting controlled substances.
- Renee Hernandez – Resisting, obstructing, delaying an officer and violation of probation.
- Gustavo Alvizar – Possession of a loaded, concealed firearm and violation of probation.

All four were booked into the Solano County Jail.
