### **Narrative:**

On May 11, 2009 at 3:31 p.m., Vacaville Police and Fire Departments responded to an injury collision that occurred at the intersection of Leisure Town Road and Poplar Road. When Officers arrived on scene, they found a 1986 Honda motorcycle underneath a Grey 2007 Ford F150 pickup. Witnesses stated that a school bus loaded with children was stopped N/B Leisure Town Road just north of Poplar Road next to the curb with its red flashing lights on. The rider of the motorcycle, later identified as 58 year old Jack Inman (Vacaville resident), was on N/B Leisure Town Road and had stopped for the school bus. The driver of the Ford F150, later identified as 24 year old Scott McCoy (Sacramento resident), rear ended Inman's motorcycle. Inman was ejected off the motorcycle and he landed approximately 80 feet from the site of impact and landed in front of the school. The school bus was not involved in the collision. Inman was taken to UC Davis Medical Center by the Vacaville Fire Department. His injuries are unknown at this time. McCoy was not injured in the collision. The collision is still under investigation.
