Narrative:

On the above date and time, Detectives from the Vacaville Police Department's Narcotics Enforcement Team (NET) requested Fairfield Officers stop a vehicle occupied by (S) Lyons in the area of Taft Street and North Texas Street in Fairfield. Detectives had been investigating (S) Lyons for trafficking methamphetamine in both Napa and Solano Counties. A search of the vehicle by a Fairfield PD K-9 located over a half ounce of methamphetamine packaged for sale, along with a scale, cell phone, and over \$500 in suspected drug proceeds. (S) Lyons was arrested by Fairfield PD for transportation and possession of methamphetamine for sale, as well as violation of his parole terms.

Vacaville Narcotics Detectives then wrote a search warrant for 2149 Oak Street in Napa based on (S) Lyons' association with that address. With the assistance of Vacaville Crime Suppression Team (CST) Detectives and the Napa Police Department, the warrant was served at the Napa residence at 12:30 a.m. A search of the residence, which is occupied by (S) Roberts and (S) Wolter, located additional methamphetamine packaged for sale along with \$360 in suspected drug proceeds. Both subjects were arrested for possession of methamphetamine for sale and subsequently booked at the Napa County Jail.

The Vacaville Police Department has a zero tolerance policy towards illegal drug use in our community. We work closely with other nearby law enforcement agencies to target illicit drug use and sales. We also rely heavily on public information to combat the flow of drugs into our neighborhoods. Citizens with information regarding illegal drug use and sales are encouraged to call our DRUG TIP LINE at 449-5243. Callers can remain anonymous and all information is welcome.
