Narrative:

On May 27, 2009, at approximately 10:38 a.m., The Vacaville Police Communications Center received a 911 call from a female who was reporting that she had just caught someone attempting to break into her house. She told the dispatcher that she had just arrived home from running some errands and as she entered her house she saw the suspect run from her backyard. The resident confronted the suspect as he was exiting the side yard of the victim residence. The victim attempted to detain the suspect and a short struggle took place before the suspect rode off on his bicycle. The suspect was last seen riding S/B on North Alamo Drive. The victim suffered a small cut to her leg.

Officers began to search the area for the suspect with the assistance of the California Highway Patrol Helicopter, Detectives from the Vacaville Police Department and the Vacaville Police Department K-9 unit. During the search, numerous neighbors reported seeing the suspect fleeing the area on his bicycle. After an extensive search the suspect was not located.

This also serves as a reminder that as the weather get warmer residents need to make sure they lock both their door and windows when they leave their house, even if it's for a short period of time.
