Narrative:

On May 27, 2009, Detectives from the Vacaville Police Department, Family Investigative Response Services Team (F.I.R.S.T.) received information that S1-Michael Savage and S2-Brandon Savage had been involved in the sexual abuse of a minor. F.I.R.S.T. Detectives obtained evidence and statements that led to the identification of S1-Michael Savage and S2-Brandon Savage as suspects in this case.

F.I.R.S.T. Detectives, with the assistance of the Fairfield Police Department, the Richmond Police Department and the California Army National Guard, attempted to locate S1-Michael Savage at his Richmond address without success.

On May 28, 2009, F.I.R.S.T. Detectives conducted surveillance in Richmond, California. F.I.R.S.T. Detectives with the assistance of the Richmond Police Department located S1-Michael Savage at his place of employment.

(California Army National Guard Depot, 624 Carlson Boulevard) S1-Savage was taken into custody without incident and booked into the Solano County Jail.

S2-Brandon Savage was located at the Solano County Jail where he was arrested. He is being held on unrelated charges of possession of a stolen vehicle, evading the police and probation violation. He will be sentenced on August 12, 2009 on those unrelated charges.

The Vacaville Police Department (Family Investigative Response Services Team) is actively investigating this case. The Vacaville Police Department would urge adults and minors to be aware of persons who would use alcohol or drugs as an excuse to befriend you.
