### **Narrative:**

On the above date and time, Detectives from the Narcotics Enforcement (NET) and Crime Suppression Teams (CST) stopped and detained (S) Tharon on Alamo Drive at I-80. Narcotics Detectives had been investigating (S) Tharon for drug trafficking from his residence on Andrea Drive in Vacaville. A probation search was conducted at the home he had just left on Weatherly Way which is occupied by (S) Tenesha and (S) Beverly. During the search, thirty-four (34) marijuana plants were found growing in the backyard of the residence. The home was secured and Detectives contacted a judge who issued a search warrant for the residence. A further search of the home located methamphetamine and evidence of drug sales, along with two loaded handguns and a shotgun. A search warrant was also executed at the 100 block of Andrea Drive which is a home shared by (S) Tharon and (S) Denean.

All four suspects were arrested for cultivation of marijuana. Suspects, Tharon, Beverly and Tenesha Roberts were all arrested for being armed during the commission of a felony. Suspects, Tharon, Beverly and Denean were all arrested for being part of a criminal conspiracy. (S) Tenesha was also arrested for possession of methamphetamine for sale. All four suspects were transported to the county jail in Fairfield for booking.

The Vacaville Police Department has a zero tolerance policy towards illegal drug sales and use in our community. While California State Law authorizes some individuals to possess small amounts of marijuana for medical purposes, the cultivation or possession of marijuana for sale is illegal and not sanctioned or allowed by the Police Department.
