Narrative:

On the above date and time, Detectives from the Vacaville Police Department's Narcotics Enforcement (NET) and Crime Suppression Teams (CST) served a search warrant at the above location with the assistance of the Fairfield Police Department. The search warrant was the culmination of a brief investigation into (s) Poujade's sales of methamphetamine by Vacaville Narcotics Detectives. A search of the premises located methamphetamine and evidence of drug sales along with narcotic paraphernalia.

(S) Poujade, the homeowner, was arrested for maintaining a drug house and violation of his probation terms. Suspects Severa and Welch were both arrested for possession of methamphetamine. (S) Welch was also arrested for possession of narcotic paraphernalia and an outstanding traffic warrant. (S) Velasquez-Jandreau was arrested for possession of methamphetamine for sale and possession of a hypodermic syringe. All of the suspects were booked at the County Jail in Fairfield. (S) Gary Horton, a wanted parolee, fled the residence during the service of the search warrant. Fairfield Officers searched the area for (s) Horton without success and he is still outstanding.

The Vacaville Police Department has a zero tolerance policy towards illegal drug use in our community. We work closely with the Fairfield Police Department to protect our citizenry and rely heavily on public information to combat the flow of drugs into our neighborhoods.
