### **UPDATE 06/26/09**

On June 25, 2009 at 5:30 p.m., S-Timothy Fisher surrendered to Deputies of the Solano County Sheriff's Office. S-Fisher and S-Luther are both being house at the Solano County Sheriff's Fairfield Jail at this time. The Vacaville Police Department is once again asking anyone with information about this series of robberies to contact Detective Chris Polen at (707) 449-4724 or (707)44-5200.

### **END OF UPDATE**

#### **Narrative:**

On June 16, 2009, Detective Chris Polen began working a series of robberies that were occurring in the City of Vacaville. The crimes being committed in our jurisdiction were similar to several crimes being reported in the Cities of Fairfield and Suisun. Detective Polen began sharing information and working together with these allied agencies. This cooperation resulted in the identification of two suspects in the Vacaville cases.

The names of the two suspects are Bradley Luther and Timothy Fisher. S- Luther has been identified as a responsible in three robberies in Vacaville; the Domino's Pizza on Peabody Road was robbed on June 12, 2009. The Union 76 Gas Station on Alamo Drive was victimized on June 15, 2009 and the 7/11 Store on East Monte Vista Avenue was the victim of a robbery on June 15, 2009. S- Bradley is being charged in all three of these crimes.

An arrest warrant for \$250,000.00 has been obtained for S-Timothy Fisher for both the 7/11 robbery and the Union 76 gas station robbery. S-Fisher knows that he is wanted and believed to be hiding somewhere in the Bay Area. S- Fisher should be considered armed and dangerous. A hand gun was used in each of these robberies and is still outstanding.
