UPDATED PRESS RELEASE (07-17-09)

The Pennington County State Attorney's Office (Rapid City, South Dakota) notified the Vacaville Police Department that S-Frank Ashley was sentenced today for the crimes for which he was convicted. S-Ashley received a 135 year prison sentence. He is eligible for parole after he serves 67.5 years.

Narrative:

On July 8, 2008, the Vacaville Police Department received information that a juvenile female had been the victim of continuous and substantial sexual molestation. The case was assigned to detectives from the Family Investigative Response Services Team (F.I.R.S.T.) who initiated an investigation. Detectives interviewed the victim and gathered evidence of the crimes.

Detectives from the Family Investigative Response Services Team (FIRST), Officers from the Youth Services Section (YSS) and Officers from Uniformed Patrol made contact with the suspect as he was attempting to leave his residence. The suspect who was positively identified as S-Ashley was taken into custody without incident. S-Ashley was booked into the Solano County Jail. His bail was set at \$111,667.
