### Narrative:

On July 16, 2009 at 9:49 p.m., Vacaville Police responded to the 200 block of Brown Street to investigate a hit and run collision that had just occurred. The suspect vehicle had collided with three parked vehicles and fled the scene. Officers located the suspect vehicle at the corner of Brown Street and East Monte Vista Avenue.

Upon locating the suspect vehicle, officers discovered that the driver, Ricardo Pineda-Pedraza as well as his two passengers, a 13-year-old girl and 7-year-old boy, had minor injuries as a result of the collision. Mr. Pineda-Pedraza was arrested at the scene for driving under the influence of alcohol causing injuries, hit and run with injuries and child endangerment. The two juveniles, as well as Mr. Pineda-Pedraza, were treated at the scene for minor injuries by the Vacaville Fire Department. The juveniles were released to their mother and Mr. Pineda Pedraza was booked into the Solano County Jail.
