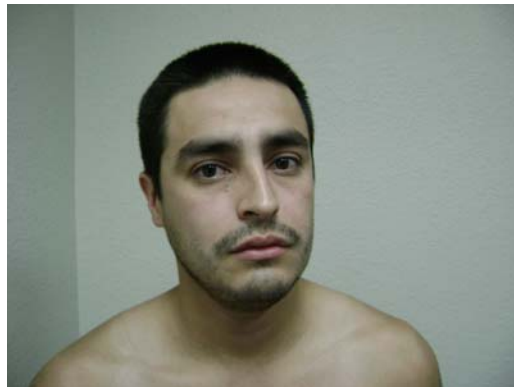
### Narrative:

On July 19, 2009, Vacaville Patrol Officers and Detectives from the Vacaville Police Department Family Investigative Response Services Team (F.I.R.S.T.), responded to a south Vacaville residence regarding a rape that had occurred. The investigation revealed the victim awoke in the morning and found the patio sliding screen door partially ajar. She was subsequently confronted by the suspect in the hallway of the residence where she was sexually assaulted. After the sexual assault, the suspect told the victim he was going to the kitchen to get a knife. As the suspect entered the kitchen, the victim fled the residence through the front door. As the victim fled, the suspect fled the residence through a rear door.

Detectives from the Family Investigative Response Services Team (F.I.R.S.T.) were notified by the California Department of Justice Laboratory that evidence which had been collected by a Vacaville Police Department ID Technician was analyzed and a positive match was made identifying S-Ramirez as the responsible for the sexual assault.

An arrest and search warrant was obtained this morning for S-Ramirez and Detectives from the Family Investigative Response Services Team (F.I.R.S.T.) , Investigative Services Section (ISS), Crime Suppression Team (CST), Narcotics Enforcement Team (NET), a canine team including agents from CDCR Parole began to search at several locations in Vacaville throughout the day for S-Ramirez.

Vacaville Detectives went to a residence in the 700 block of La Cruz Lane and located S-Ramirez. He was taken into custody at 5:11 p.m. and will be booked into Solano County Jail for the above listed charges in addition to 422 PC-Criminal Threats, 236 PC-False Imprisonment, and 3056 PC (parole hold).
