Narrative:

On July 26, 2009 at 4:56 a.m., the Vacaville Police Department received the report of an alarm from a business at 801 Davis Street. A commercial burglary was discovered at this business. While responding to the alarm, Officer Yetter observed a white panel van entering I-80 eastbound from the Davis Street on-ramp. The van was traveling at an accelerated speed on the onramp.

Officer Yetter got behind the van and ran a check on the license plate. The van was bearing a license plate that had been reported stolen. Officer Yetter attempted to conduct an enforcement stop on the van, using his emergency lights, but the van accelerated away. The van stopped briefly as if it were yielding; however, two occupants were observed exiting and running away from the van. The driver then continued away.

The driver then slowed and leapt from van while it was still in motion on eastbound I-80. Despite trying to run from the pursuing Officer, the driver, S-Seeley, was apprehended after a foot pursuit. S-Seeley sustained minor injuries from his leap from the moving van. S-Seeley is currently on parole.

Other Officers conversing on the area located S-Martinez and S-Bacud in the area of Nut Tree Parkway. Both S-Martinez and S-Bacud were positively identified and linked to the van by other evidence.

The van was found to be a stolen vehicle and had been re-plated with the stolen license plates. Located in the van was thousands of dollars of stolen property from the business that had been burglarized. There is some conflicting information as to whether all of the burglars were captured or not. There may be at least one outstanding suspect. The investigation is continuing.

S-Seeley was charged with Burglary, Vehicle Theft, Possession of Stolen Property, Possession of Burglary Tools, Conspiracy, Resisting and Obstructing an Officer, Evading (Pursuit), and Parole Violation.

S-Martinez was charged with Burglary, Possession of Stolen Property, Possession of Burglary Tools, Conspiracy, and Resisting and Obstructing an Officer.
