Narrative:

The Vacaville Police Department conducted a multi-agency Sex Offender Compliance Sweep on August 20, 2009 between 2:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. The purpose of the Sex Offender Compliance Sweep was to ensure convicted sex offenders and sexually violent predators are in compliance with their registration, probation or parole conditions. This operation involved Detectives from the Vacaville Police Department Family Investigative Response Services Team (F.I.R.S.T.) and Investigative Support Services (I.S.S.), the Vacaville Police Department Crime Suppression Team (C.S.T.), Vacaville Police Tactical Dispatchers, Vacaville Police Records Clerks and Vacaville Crime Analysis, along with Probation Officers from Solano County Probation, Parole Agents from the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation, Fairfield 2 GPS Parole Unit and Deputy U.S. Marshals from the United States Marshals Service.

The operation involved four teams that visited designated locations throughout Vacaville. The teams conducted thirty-eight (38) compliance checks and made two (2) arrests. The Vacaville Police Department and our allied agencies from the County, State and Federal Government are committed to the safety of our Community. This sex offender sweep would not have been possible without the invaluable cooperation and partnership with our allied agencies and the community.
