Narrative:

On the above date and time, Detectives from the Vacaville Police Department's Narcotics Enforcement Team (NET) and Crime Suppression Team (CST) served a search warrant in the 300 block of Kent Way in Vacaville where (s)Patrick Wehner was stopped while driving a motor vehicle. The search warrant was the culmination of a six month investigation into (s)Wehner's sales of methamphetamine by Vacaville narcotics detectives. A search of Wehner's vehicle located methamphetamine packaged for sale, evidence of drug sales, and a 10mm semi-automatic handgun. (s)Wehner was subsequently arrested for transportation and possession for sale of methamphetamine.

A search of the apartment (s)Wehner had just left at 1700 Block of Marshall Road located additional methamphetamine and evidence of drug sales. (s)Carmela Obregon, the primary tenant of the apartment, was arrested there for possession of methamphetamine for sale. Detectives also seized \$675 in suspected drug proceeds from (s)Wehner and (s)Obregon.

Detectives traveled to Wehner's apartment at 1500 Block of Alamo Drive where an additional search was conducted. (s)Amanda Etzel, a resident of the apartment, was located inside and arrested for two outstanding felony warrants. All three arrestees were transported to the county jail in Fairfield for booking.
