Narrative:

On October 11, 2009, Vacaville Patrol Officers received information from Solano County Child Welfare Services that an infant was being treated at the University of California at Davis Medical Center for being under the influence of marijuana. The infant and another child were subsequently placed into protective custody.

Detectives from the Family Investigative Response Services Team (F.I.R.S.T.) assumed the investigation. The investigation showed the infant was exposed to marijuana and inhaled or ingested enough marijuana to result in the infant needing immediate medical attention. Detectives and social workers from Solano Child Welfare Services concluded the investigation. The investigation led to S-Velasquez being identified as the person responsible for endangering the welfare of the infant by placing the infant in an environment to ingest or inhale marijuana.

S-Velasquez was taken into custody and booked into the Solano County Jail without incident. Anyone who believes they may have information regarding this case is asked to call Detective Erwin Ramirez at 707-469-6610.
