S- Jared Travis Walker, (DOB 12/26/1989) of Fairfield

Charges:

1. 245 A2 PC – Assault with deadly weapon gun
2. 211 PC – Robbery
3. 12022B PC – Use of a firearm
4. 11360 (A) H&S – Sell, furnish marijuana

S-Jared Walker has been identified as the shooter in the incident that occurred on October 23, 2009 in the area of 1100 Alamo Drive. On November 4, 2009 at approximately 7:00 PM, Detective Adam Senf of the Crime Suppression Team (CST), conducted a vehicle stop on S-Walker. He was arrested without incident at that time. S-Walker was booked into Solano County Jail on the charges listed above. A search warrant was also served at S-Walker's residence, located in the 2500 block of Frietas Way, Fairfield.

The investigation has revealed that this shooting was the result of a drug deal gone bad. The victim of the shooting was attempting to sell marijuana to S-Walker. S-Walker attempted to steal the drugs with the use of a handgun. S-Walker shot the victim once in the leg during this altercation. The handgun used in this crime has not yet been identified. The victim received a broken leg as a result of the gun shot. He has been released from the hospital but will require additional medical care.



The Vacaville Police Department is committed to stopping this type of senseless violence on our streets. We will continue to use all the resources available to combat this type of crime. Narrative:

On October 23, 2009 at 6:21 PM, officers were dispatched to the 5300 block of Alonzo Road for a 19 year old male suffering from a gunshot wound to the leg. The victim's stepmother called 911 and stated her son had been shot in the area of 1100 Alamo Drive. The victim drove himself home after the shooting. On arrival, officers discovered the 19 year old male in the front seat of his vehicle at his residence. He had a single gunshot wound to the leg.

A preliminary investigation revealed the shooting occurred inside the victim's vehicle. An investigation into the suspect's identity is underway. The victim was transported by ambulance to Kaiser Hospital in Vacaville. His injuries were believed to be non-life threatening.

Detectives from the Investigative Services Section were called out to assist with the case. The investigation is ongoing. Anyone with information should contact Detective Todd Dye at (707) 449-5212.
