Narrative:

On November 7, 2009 at approximately 10:21p.m., Officer Hopper responded to the area of Shasta Drive at Tahoe Drive in reference to an attempt strong arm robbery. The victim described the suspects as 4-6 BM's between the ages of 16-18 years old. The suspects wore dark Hoodie sweatshirts with the hoods pulled tight over their heads. The suspects attempted to attack the victim but the victim was able to run away from the suspects.

At approximately 11:35 p.m., Officer Miller responded to the area of Spindrift Drive near Trysail in reference to a strong arm robbery. The young female was walking home when she was approached by six BM's between the ages of 16-18 years old. The suspects were wearing Hoodie sweatshirts with the hood pulled tight over their heads. The suspects took the victim's money and fled on foot on Trysail towards Bowline Drive. An area check was conducted with negative results. The CHP helicopter (H-30) was contacted and they were unable to locate the suspects. Officer Moriarty entered the area of Spindrift and Trysail with his lights turned off when noticed several pairs of legs running from a commercial truck into a set a bushes on the side of a residence. Officer Moriarty broadcasted his situation and detained the suspects at gun point until addition units arrived. The victim's property was recovered and the victim positively identified the suspects as the ones who robbed her. All four juveniles were arrested for robbery and conspiracy, and they were transported to Juvenile Hall.
