Narrative:

On the above date and time, Detectives from the Narcotics Enforcement (NET) and Crime Suppression Teams (CST) served a search warrant at 100 Block of E. Deodara Street in Vacaville. The search warrant was the result of a short term investigation of s-Chris Stouffer by Vacaville Narcotics Detectives for sales of marijuana. A search of the residence located approximately one pound of processed marijuana and concentrated cannabis, ecstasy pills and over two ounces of cocaine. Approximately 162 small marijuana plants were located in an indoor grow room outfitted with a sophisticated lighting, ventilation and irrigation system. Detectives seized evidence of drug sales and \$476 in suspected drug proceeds from the residence. The primary tenant, s-Chris Stouffer was arrested for cultivation and possession of marijuana for sale, possession of cocaine for sale, possession of ecstasy, and child endangerment. A six year old child was removed from the home by Solano County Child Protective Services. S-Mr. Stouffer was subsequently transported to the County jail in Fairfield for booking.

The Vacaville Police Department has a zero tolerance policy towards illegal drug sales and use in our community. While California State Law authorizes some individuals to possess small amounts of marijuana for medical purposes, the cultivation or possession of marijuana for sale is illegal and not sanctioned or allowed by the Police Department. The public is encouraged to report all suspected drug activity to our DRUG TIP LINE at 449-5243. Callers can remain anonymous and all information is welcome.
