### **Narrative:**

On Saturday, December 5, 2009, Vacaville Police Youth Services Section officers worked an enforcement detail at Vacaville High School's Winter Ball. The dance was held at the City of Vacaville's Cultural Center from 8 p.m. to midnight.

Prior to entering the facility, all attendees were checked for concealment of alcoholic beverages or signs of intoxication. There were more than 700 students and their guests who entered the building and only one student was found to be in possession of empty containers in her purse. The student denied consumption of any of the beverages and stated she was holding them for friends whom she refused to identify. The liquor bottle and two flasks were removed from her possession, she was denied entry to the school event and was released to her father.

This event was conducted in cooperation with Vacaville High School's Administrative Team and was funded through a grant awarded to the City of Vacaville by the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. More enforcement activity, also funded by this same grant, is planned in the future.
