Location: Stevenson Street / Elizabeth Street
Suspects: Suspect #1 - White male adult or Hispanic male adult, mid to late 20's, 5'10" medim build, wearing red plaid lined jacket with matching hood, dark pants and black ski mask with one large hole for the eyes.

Suspect #2 - White male adult or Hispanic male adult, mid to late 20's, 510-600 medium - large build, shoulder length "greasy" black hair in a ponytail, wearing a light colored jacket / possibly tan in color.

Narrative:

On December 21, 2009, Officers responded to the 500 block of Davis Street for a robbery that had occurred. Officers met with the victim at another location and learned the following:

The victim was driving westbound Stevenson Street from the 500 block of Davis Street at around 6:00 AM. The victim observed Suspect #1 and Suspect #2 walking westbound on Stevenson Street near Elizabeth Street. Prior to Elizabeth Street, Suspect #2 jumped in front of his car while Suspect #1 climbed in the back seat. Suspect #1 stated he had a gun and asks for victim's wallet. Suspect #1 searched wallet and ordered victim to drive to ATM after discovering no cash inside the wallet. The victim drove to a nearby bank and used ATM to withdrawal cash. Suspect #1 ordered victim to drive back to the location where the crime started (Stevenson / Elizabeth). Suspect #1 then fled the vehicle at this location.

An extensive area search was conducted, including the use of a police K-9. The suspects were not apprehended and remain at large.
