Narrative:

On August 13, 2009 at approximately 12:30 p.m., Officer Sampson responded to the Nut Tree Factory Store Outlets regarding a report of several subjects inside the Nike Outlet who appeared to be in the process of stealing shoes from the store. The suspects left the store prior to the officer's arrival, but employees were able to provide a description of the suspects and the vehicle they fled in. A records check of the license plate revealed the vehicle was reported stolen from Vallejo. A broadcast was issued to surrounding agencies and a Fairfield officer observed the vehicle traveling westbound on I-80 a short time later. A vehicle pursuit ensued and CHP officers assumed control of the pursuit.

The vehicle pursuit continued into Vallejo and ended with the suspects losing control of the vehicle and colliding with a stop sign. The suspects exited the vehicle and fled into the surrounding neighborhood. With the assistance of CHP, Vallejo Police Department officers, and air support, the four above referenced suspects were taken into custody. One suspect sustained minor injuries and had to be transported to the hospital for medical treatment. One suspect is still outstanding at this time.

Officer Sampson responded to Vallejo and recovered stolen property from Nike, Factory Brand Shoes, Zumiez, and Vans. Her investigation revealed all four suspects were involved in the above referenced crimes.
