HIGH-SPEED CHASE ENDS IN ARREST OF DRIVER ON VARIOUS CHARGES

Vacaville police arrested a 19-year-old man early Sunday morning following a high-speed chase that reached speeds in excess of 100 miles per hour.

Sean McMahon, 19, of Vacaville was booked into Solano County Jail for assault with a deadly weapon and evading a police officer.

The arrest occurred after Vacaville police were dispatched to the parking lot of Soccer Nation, 3777 Vaca Valley Parkway, following reports of a fight involving approximately 50 people. As officers entered the parking lot, a gold Honda Accord occupied by two male subjects was leaving the scene at a high rate of speed, nearly colliding with incoming patrol cars.

Moments later officers determined McMahon, the driver of the Honda Accord, was responsible for using his vehicle to hit two people while in the parking lot. Officers then followed the vehicle and attempted to make a traffic stop, but McMahon sped away. After reaching speeds of over 100 mph on westbound Highway 80, the car ultimately pulled over near the I-505 interchange. McMahon was taken into custody without incident and transported to Vaca Valley Hospital where he was treated for minor injuries that resulted from the earlier fight in the parking lot.

The two victims hit by the Honda sustained minor injuries, and only one was transported to Vaca Valley Hospital for medical treatment.
