14-YEAR-OLD JUVENILE ARRESTED FOR ARSON AT ALAMO CREEK PARK

Vacaville Police on Sunday evening arrested a 14-year-old male on suspicion of arson and a probation violation.

At approximately 6:47 p.m., Sunday police responded to a call from residents that three juveniles were attempting to light a fire near a play structure at Alamo Creek Park. Upon their arrival, officers encountered three juveniles – two males and a female – walking away from the park. The 14-year-old juvenile male then told officers he was bored and had ignited a corn chip bag, which resulted in the scorching of the play structure. Vacaville Fire responded to the park, making sure the fire was out.

At that point, the 14-year-old was arrested and booked into Solano County Juvenile Hall for suspicion of arson as well as violation of probation for two prior arson incidents in Vacaville.
