POLICE PROSTITUTION STING RESULTS IN THREE ARRESTS

As part of an ongoing effort to curtail prostitution in Vacaville, detectives from the Vacaville Police Department's Investigative Services Section (ISS) conducted a sting operation for prostitution in Vacaville that resulted in several arrests.

On March 3, 2010, S-Johnson, S-Stockman and S-Carter were all arrested for prostitution as well as being an unlicensed escort. All of these women contacted an undercover officer and agreed to complete a sex act for a specific amount of money. S-Johnson was also arrested for being in possession of a stolen vehicle and possessing a controlled substance, valium. All three women were booked into Solano County Jail. No booking photos are available.

The goal of these operations is to curtail this activity in Vacaville as well as maintain safety in our neighborhoods for our residents and visitors alike. Often the people involved in this type of criminal enterprise are also committing other crimes.
