Narrative:

On March 5, 2010 at approximately 6:50 p.m., the Vacaville Communications Center received a 911 call concerning a shooting in the 100 block of Meadows Drive. Callers reported that a group of young men had fired multiple shots with handguns on a group of people. The suspects then fled the scene in a light colored Chevy Impala.

Patrol officers responding to the scene found two victims with gunshot wounds. The first victim, a 17 year old male, was suffering from multiple gun shots and was transported to a local emergency room for treatment of his injuries. The victim did not survive his wounds and was pronounced dead at the hospital.

The second victim suffered a single gunshot wound and was transported by air ambulance to a nearby trauma center. This victim is a 15 year old male that underwent surgery for his wounds and is expected to survive.

Officers saw a vehicle matching the description of the suspects leaving the City of Vacaville. An enforcement stop was attempted but the occupants fled from police and a pursuit ensued through the City of Fairfield. The pursuit ended when the suspect's vehicle crashed on Dickson Hill Road at Mustang Circle. Three suspects were taken into custody at that time.

S-Ortega, S-Torres and S-Vidrio were all booked into jail on multiple charges including murder, attempted murder, felony evading and conspiracy. This appears to be a gang related shooting that could lead to the filing of additional charges.
