SEVEN ARRESTED IN SEX OFFENDER COMPLIANCE SWEEP

Police arrested seven people on Thursday during a sex offender sweep conducted by the Vacaville Police Department's Family Investigative Response Services Team (F.I.R.S.T.) and other agencies.

The goal of these compliance sweeps is to ensure those individuals on probation or parole for various sex offenses are following their terms of release. Police conducted 49 compliance checks, which resulted in the seven arrests. A majority of the arrests during this operation were for possession of contraband in violation of the terms of the individual's probation or parole. One person was arrested for a warrant issued out of Texas that involved a sexual assault on a child.

Those arrested during the operation are all Vacaville residents. They are:
