### **FIVE ARRESTED ON VEHICLE THEFT, BURGLARY CHARGES**

Vacaville police arrested five people early Sunday morning on a variety of charges related to a stolen vehicle.

At around 1:45 a.m., Sunday morning, police noticed a car in the Stonegate neighborhood trying to avoid being seen by a police patrol car. The vehicle suddenly stopped and one of the passengers jumped out and fled into a backyard of a home on Fallen Leaf Circle.

Police then contacted the remaining four passengers in the car and, during a search of the vehicle, discovered stolen property that included a purse and a car stereo. With the help of a California Highway Patrol helicopter, a Vacaville Police K-9 unit located and then took into custody the individual who had run away from the vehicle.

During the search, a stolen vehicle was discovered parked in the neighborhood. Officers later contacted a witness who reported that three of the people apprehended had been seen inside it and acting suspiciously.

Officers also discovered the suspects were in possession of stolen property from the stolen vehicle.
