VACAVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT ARRESTS THEFT SUSPECTS

Vacaville Police on Friday evening arrested three suspects after they allegedly took property without paying for it from several stores at the Vacaville Premium Outlets and several other locations.

A store employee at Burberry, a clothing retailer located at the Outlets, informed police that several individuals were seen taking property without paying for the items. Officers responded to the store and made contact with S-



Breckenridge (who is on active parole in Contra Costa County), S-Nguyen (who is on probation for theft in Alameda County) and S-Pasana (who is on probation for burglary in Alameda County).

Officers recovered approximately \$10,000 in stolen property from Burberry, Louis Vuitton, Eddie Bauer, Toys-R-Us and several other retail stores in northern California. The suspects were subsequently arrested and booked into the Solano County Jail. The stolen property was returned to the respective businesses or booked as evidence.

Officers determined that the suspects were stealing the property and selling the property on E-Bay. Officers located several of the recovered items advertised for sale on E-Bay. Officers were able to contact victims in North Carolina and in Barstow, California.
