WOMEN ARRESTED ON FIREARMS, CHILD ENDANGERMENT CHARGES

Vacaville police arrested a pair of residents after one of the women allegedly pointed a handgun at someone.

The victim contacted police to tell them that Heather Miller, 23, had pointed a handgun at her in the 1300 block of Callen Street, and then left on foot. Officers conducted an area check and located Miller and Karina De Haro, 20, at the corner of Callen Street and E. Monte Vista Avenue. Both were pushing strollers with small children inside.

During a search of the women's belongings, police discovered a loaded 9 mm handgun in a purse that belonged to De Haro. The purse was located on a stroller in which De Haro's 18-month-old daughter was sitting.

Both women were arrested for possession of a loaded firearm, brandishing a firearm and felony child endangerment and were transported to Solano County Jail in Fairfield.
