SACRAMENTO VEHICLE THEFT ENDS WITH ARRESTS IN FAIRFIELD

A vehicle stolen in Sacramento made its way to Vacaville before police stopped and arrested three suspects in the parking lot of a Fairfield restaurant.

According to the victim, on Thursday evening his Acura Integra was stolen from the driveway of his home in Sacramento. After hearing the car's engine start, he looked out to see the car being driven away. He then took his girlfriend's car and followed the suspects.

The victim called Vacaville police at approximately 9:34 p.m. from a pay phone to report that his vehicle had been driven to the Jack in the Box on Leisure Town Road in Vacaville. The suspects got back into the stolen Acura and drove away, with the victim following them from a safe distance.

At that point, a member of Vacaville Police Department's Crime Suppression Team located the stolen Acura traveling west on Interstate 80, approaching Fairfield.

The suspects drove the victim's vehicle into the parking lot of a Denny's Restaurant in Fairfield, where several Vacaville and Fairfield police officers conducted a high-risk stop and arrested the three suspects without incident.

Jose Alvarez, 26, and his cousin, Rodolfo Alvarez, 24, were arrested for stealing a vehicle and conspiracy to commit the theft. The 17-year-old juvenile was also arrested and taken to Juvenile Hall for stealing a vehicle, conspiracy and violating his probation.
