### **VACAVILLE POLICE IDENTIFY SUSPECT IN GANG-RELATED SHOOTING**

Vacaville police have identified a suspect in the triple shooting that took place on May 3 on Rocky Hill Road.

S-Victor Serriteno, 18, of Vacaville is described as 5 feet, 8 inches tall and weighing 200 pounds. Police say he's the person who opened fire on a group of people as they stood outside a home washing a car on a Monday afternoon.

On Friday, May 14, Vacaville police detectives, members of the Department's Investigative Services Division (ISS), and the Department's SWAT Team served search and arrest warrants on Serriteno's home. During the search, police located evidence related to the case, but S-Serriteno was not at home.

Detectives are actively searching for S-Serriteno, and are asking anyone with information on his whereabouts to call the police department at 449-5200.

In the May 3rd shooting, S-Serriteno and another Hispanic male walked up to a group of eight people. S-Serriteno then began shooting into the group. Three people were struck by gunfire, with two being seriously injured. The rest of the group fled into a nearby house and avoided injury.

S-Serriteno and the other suspect then ran to a maroon Dodge Caravan and fled north on Rocky Hill Road. The vehicle was later located, but no suspects were found.
