Narrative:

On Friday, May 28, 2010, Officers from the Vacaville Police Department Youth Services Section worked a directed enforcement detail focused on combating youth obtaining alcoholic beverages. Two juvenile decoys, working with the officers, stood in front of a convenience store and asked adults to buy beer for them. More than 20 adults were asked and most of them refused. However, the decoys were successful four times, which led to the arrests of five adults.

Three separate incidents led to the arrests of Larry Miranda, Brian Grecik, and Daniel Terry who agreed to make the purchase, completed the purchase, and then gave the alcoholic beverages to the decoys. As soon as the transfer was complete, the adults were contacted by officers and arrested.

In the other incident, 19-year-old Shanita Solomon agreed to the request and collected the money but since she was too young to make the purchase her companion, 21-year old Angela Lencioni, bought the beer. Lencioni then gave the beer to Solomon, knowing that she was too young to possess alcoholic beverages. Solomon then gave the beer to the decoys. Both suspects were arrested for furnishing alcoholic beverages to a minor. All of the adults were released on a Promise to Appear.

This operation was made possible by funding from a grant that was awarded to the Vacaville Police Department by the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. Additional proactive enforcement actions such as these will be taking place in the future. Residents are encouraged to report suspected illegal activity to the Police Department by calling the 24-hour non-emergency number 449-5200.
